Hi John,

There is no "Official" count but here are the numbers I am using when asked:

-61 total births, not including the two premature births in December or January. The first healthy birth was 2/8. the 61st and final was 3/19.

-42 births on CPB which includes 1 stillbirth and 5 or 6 abandoned and rescued pups.

-19 births on South Casa.

-Lifeguards saw 2 pups on Wipeout but did not witness the actual births so I will not say for certain they occurred there.

I derived these numbers by listening to multiple sources. Accuracy is not guaranteed. I am not aware of any policy decisions that will be made based on these numbers. Rich
